## COVID-19 Screening & Disclaimer

*(Updated January 2021. Subject to change as conditions and guidelines require.)*

Brazilian Art Soccer residential camps will only be held if conditions are safe. With the vaccination for COVID-19 currently in distribution, we are anticipating that we will be able to hold our overnight camps as normal (or near normal) in July. For now, our policies and procedures for campers' health and safety will follow State and CDC guidelines, and will change as those guidelines change. Some form of screening may still be required for each camper, and may include some or all of the following:

- Covid-19 questionnaire with parent signature
- Quarantine prior to camp
- Covid-19 negative test prior to camp
- Temperature checks at arrival, and on a daily basis
- Proof of vaccination (it is unclear whether this will be contained in the State's guidelines)

Again, we anticipate that conditions will be vastly improved by July 2021, so this screening and disclaimer will be updated as required.

## Medical and Photo Release

### Health Policies and Guidelines

Brazilian Art (BA) Soccer does have a healthcare consultant, Doctor Russell Coleman, on-call. Our consultant has advised us on our health policies, and will always be available to advise us in both acute and chronic medical situations. As part of our health care policy, BA Soccer cannot accept any child with a diagnosed communicable disease (measles, mumps, chicken pox, etc). Please do not send your child to camp if he/she shows signs of possible contagious diseases (new cold, sore throat, fever, rashes, diarrhea, vomiting, etc). A parent should not bring their child to our camp if he/she is too ill to participate in activities, if the child requires special attention due to their illness, or if any signs or poor health are evident. The health of all children and staff is in jeopardy if an ill child is allowed to attend. Parents must notify the staff if their child has been exposed to and infectious disease so we can alert the families of the children attending the program. If during the day the BA staff notices a child is unable to participate in activities due to poor health, the parent or emergency contact will be called to come and pick up the child. It is the responsibility of the parent to notify BA Soccer if there should be any changes regarding emergency contacts. If you decide that your child should remain at home, please call 603-557-4362 and inform BA Soccer of the absence. You have the right to request in writing to review the background of our counselors and our health care, discipline and grievance policies/procedures.

### A parent or legal guardian should complete the following.

I hereby certify that the above-mentioned participant is in good health and fully able to participate in all the activities of Brazilian Art Soccer Training. I agree that Brazilian Art Soccer Training and their Directors and Trainers will not be held responsible for any accident or loss to the participant however caused and hereby release Brazilian Art Soccer Training from all claims or damages which may arise from any accident or loss. I understand that every effort will be made to contact me in the event of an emergency requiring medical attention for my child. However; if I cannot be reached I hereby authorize Brazilian Art Soccer to act on my behalf should any emergency arise, and hereby grant permission to said administrators to authorize medical attention recommended by a physician, nurse, or hospital, and if needed to transport my child to Lowell General Hospital (Lowell, MA) or Saint Joseph's Hospital (Nashua, NH) for necessary medical treatment. I understand the staff members of Brazilian Art Soccer are trained in the basics of First Aid and I authorize them to give my child first aid when appropriate.

# Medical Care Authorization

**Brazilian Art Soccer's policy on the administration and storage of medication is as follows:**

- Medication must arrive in the prescription container with date, dosage, doctor's name and order.
- A parent must sign the medication permission form, writing the purpose of the medication, the date and times of administration, and the amount given.
- Medication must be handed directly to an administrator, not left in the child's possession.
- Medication shall only be administered by the health supervisor\* or by an authorized licensed health care professional. The health supervisor is a person who is at least 18 years of age, specially trained and certified in at least current American Red Cross First Aid (or its equivalent) and CPR, has been trained in the administration of medications and is under the professional oversight of a licensed health care professional authorized to administer prescription medications.

**Brazilian Art Soccer will not administer the following:**

- Non-prescription drugs (unless authorized by guardian with medication permission form)
- Medication not contained in the prescription package. Single tablets or jarred liquid will not be administered and will therefore be sent home.
- Medication in any amount exceeding the dosage indicated on the bottle.

**Storage:**

- Medication prescribed for campers shall be kept in original containers bearing the pharmacy label, which shows the date of filling, the pharmacy name and address, the filling pharmacist's initials, the serial number of the prescription, the name of the patient, the name of the prescribing practitioner, the name of the prescribed medication, directions for use and cautionary statements, if any, contained in such prescription or required by law, and if tablets or capsules, the number in the container.
- All over the counter medications for campers shall be kept in the original containers containing the original label, which shall include the directions for use.
- When no longer needed, medications shall be returned to a parent or guardian whenever possible. If the medication cannot be returned, it shall be destroyed.

### Masks and Face Coverings (PPE)

Masks and face coverings are optional for campers at Brazilian Art Soccer and are at the discretion of their parent. Staff members will wear masks. # Camp Policies and Rules: Soccer and Futsal Overnight Camp

## FOR PARENTS:

Please review the policies below, and review the rules on the next page with your children before the camp begins.

**RESPECT:** Brazilian Art Soccer and FutsalNH require our campers to show respect for the camp staff, other campers, and the facilities.

Such respect includes, among other things, using proper language, listening to directions, treating one another kindly, maintaining cleanliness, caring for the property of others and the College, and respecting the privacy of the opposite sex. We expect our campers to have fun, but to behave themselves well.

**PERSONAL PROPERTY:** Campers are responsible for their own property and possessions, including electronics, cell-phones, computers, and any equipment (e.g., ball, uniform kit) given to them as their personal property in the camp.

Brazilian Art Soccer, FutsalNH, and St. Anselm College are not responsible for the loss of campers' personal property, and will not replace lost balls or lost uniforms.

**SCHEDULE:** The Camp schedule is designed for the benefit of our campers. Campers, unless excused, are required to attend all camp training sessions.

Children will not be allowed to remain in their dorm rooms while scheduled events take place. In addition, campers will be expected to be on time for all events, including breakfast, lunch, and dinner. Coaches and counselors will be doing careful head-counts during the day, and before all scheduled events.

Campers are required to remain in their dorms after lights-out (10 P.M.) and before wake-up (7:30 A.M.). This will be strictly enforced.

**DISMISSAL:** Unruly behavior, or failure to follow camp policies and rules, could lead to automatic dismissal from the camp, without refund, according to the discretion of the Camp Director.

## FOR CAMPERS:

### I WILL

1. Be respectful to my coaches and fellow campers.
2. Respect College property and dispose of trash properly.
3. Attend all soccer/futsal sessions and be there on time.
4. Close and lock my dorm door while I am not present.
5. If I am a girl, stay in the girls dorm area; if I am a boy, stay in the boys dorm area.
6. Stay in my room and sleep/rest after 10 P.M. at night, and before 7:30 A.M. in the morning.
7. Wear my shin-guards in all soccer and futsal activities.
8. Wear a shirt and shoes in all public areas, including Davison Dining Hall.
9. Clear my tray, plate, cup, and utensils after eating.
10. Keep myself and my room clean. I will shower when I need it, brush my teeth, and make my bed in the morning.

### I WILL NOT

1. Swear or use foul language.
2. Damage my dorm room or throw trash on the ground.
3. Skip soccer/futsal sessions, or attend them late.
4. Use alcohol, tobacco, or drugs; or use matches and candles in my room.
5. Trespass into an area of the College that I am not allowed, included girls' dorms (for boys) or boys' dorms (for girls).
6. Leave my dorm wing during sleeping hours.
7. Wear my cleats indoors, including the dormitory facility.
8. Play very loud music.
9. Bully or mistreat my fellow campers.
10. Fight with or threaten other campers.
11. Leave my room at the end of the week (for checkout) without cleaning it.
