

Codes of Conduct

The Code of Conduct must be followed by all players, coaches, and parents. Failure to follow the code of conduct may result in the dismissal of the individual from the league and premises without refund.

Player's Code of Conduct

1. Always play fair and to the best of your ability.
2. Play by the rules.
3. Listen and follow the commands as directed by the referee. No complaining to the ref.
4. Shake hands with the other team and referee at the end of the game (not during covid)
5. Respect your teammates, the other team, referees, coaches, and parents.
6. Wear the appropriate required equipment.

Coach's Code of Conduct

1. Promote Fair Play and high standards of behavior.
2. Adhere to the laws and spirit of the game and always respect the officials' decisions. No complaining to the ref.
3. Respect officials, opposition players, coaches and parents.
4. Never enter the field of play without the referee's permission.
5. Never engage in public criticism of the match officials.
6. Never engage in, or tolerate from your players, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behavior.
7. Safety for player, coaches, parents are officials are a top priority.

Parent's Code of Conduct

1. Respect member, players, parents, referees and coaches.
2. Always respect the match official's decision. No yelling at the ref.
3. Remember that children play for fun.
4. Let the coach do their job and not confuse the players by coaching from the sideline.
5. Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee, and match officials.
